LICENCE GRANTED TO THE SIKH CHANNEL COMMUNITY BROADCASTING COMPANY LIMITED TO PROVIDE A TELEVISION LICENSABLE CONTENT SERVICE UNDER PART I OF THE BROADCASTING ACT 1990 ON AN APPLICATION COMPLYING WITH SECTION 235 OF THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT 2003

THE LICENCE

1. The Office of Communications ("Ofcom") in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Part I of the Broadcasting Act 1990 as amended by the Broadcasting Act 1996 and the Communications Act 2003 hereby grants The Sikh Channel Community Broadcasting Company Limited (the "Licensee") a licence (the "Licence") subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule (the "Conditions"), to provide the television licensable content service specified in the Annex (the "Licensed Service").
2. This Licence is granted on the basis of the Licensee's representations that the statements set out in the declaration as to his affairs made by the Licensee on 26 October 2012 are true to the best of the Licensee's knowledge and belief.
3. The grant date of this licence is 16 May 2005, and is the day this licence is first granted.
4. The commencement date of this Licence is 16 May 2005 (the "Commencement Date"), and is the day this Licence comes into force. Subject to the Conditions, this Licence shall remain in force until it is surrendered by the Licensee or revoked by Ofcom in accordance with the Conditions of this Licence.
The Licence was transferred to the Licensee on 08 November 2012.
