Thank you for your request for information concerning a full list of allocated amateur radio callsigns as of December 2023. Your request was received on 6 December 2023 and we have considered it under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "FOI Act").

Your request

"I would like to request a list of all UK amateur radio callsigns previously allocated as of December 2023, showing the type of the licence, the current status (e.g. allocated, reserved), and, where possible, the date of allocation for each callsign."

Our response

We are able to provide data as of the date a report is generated from our systems, in this case 7 December 2023. Therefore, please find attached a list of all UK amateur radio callsigns as of 7 December 2023, showing the callsign, the type of licence each callsign is associated with, the current status of each callsign and the date on which each callsign attained that status, where this information is held.

If you are unhappy with the response you have received in relation to your request for information and/or consider that your request was refused without a reason valid under the law, you may ask for an internal review. If you ask us for an internal review of our decision, it will be subject to an independent review within Ofcom.

The following outcomes are possible:

- the original decision is upheld; or
- the original decision is reversed or modified.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you wish to request an internal review, you should contact information.requests@ofcom.org.uk

If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
