The energy usage and cost information requested is what should be easily accessible by your energy procurement/bill validation team and so we please ask your team to complete the below and email back to us complete.

You can find some of the information you have requested in our sustainability report which can be found on pages 67 – 68 of our <u>Annual Report and Accounts 2022-2023</u>.

However, we do not hold the figures for "Est £ value of benefit received from the EBRS" for electricity or gas.

## Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
