Freedom of Information request: Right to know request

Thank you for your request for information concerning Intechnology Wifi limited/Intechnology plc's Operator status in 2016. Your request was received on 18 December 2023 and we have considered it under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "FOI Act").

Your request & our response

1. Whether Intechnology Wifi Limited (and/or its parent company Intechnology plc) was an 'Operator' on 23 August 2016?

Intechnology Wifi (now operating under the name WeLink Communications (UK) Ltd) does not appear on our systems as having Code Powers in 2016. We do not hold anything on Intechnology PLC relating to having Code Powers.

2. If it was given operator status on a later date (after 23 August 2016), the date it became an 'Operator'.

The Operator applied for Code Powers in February 2019 and was granted Powers on 31 July 2019 and can be found on our [Register of persons with powers under the Electronic Communications Code](#).

- the original decision is reversed or modified.

Timing

If you wish to exercise your right to an internal review **you should contact us within two months of the date of this letter**. There is no statutory deadline for responding to internal reviews and it will depend upon the complexity of the case. However, we aim to conclude all such reviews within 20 working days, and up to 40 working days in exceptional cases. We will keep you informed of the progress of any such review. If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
