Question 1: What is your estimate of the number of RIDs that will be required by your downstream CPs who contract with end users, at the harmonisation date of 20 June 2015?:

We estimate that 150 RIDs will be required but this includes inactive accounts. This does not take into account any additional downstream requirements - e.g. sub resellers - as we have no visibility beyond our contracted partners.

Question 2: What is your estimate of the total number of RIDs that will be required by the industry at the harmonisation date of 20 June 2015? On what basis have you reached this estimation?:

Question 3a: Do you agree with our proposal to increase number of RIDs by changing the format of the code to a three character alphanumeric code, as per option 2?:

We consider the existing RID format of three alphabetic characters more than sufficient to handle the Telecommunications industry demand for the foreseeable future. However we have no visibility of any expanded uses of the RID facility - e.g. future phases of consumer switching covering cable and other bundled services. So for future proofing we agree with the Ofcom proposal.
