Y – In order to achieve considerable growth in the Space sector the UK must become the most attractive country to grow new Space businesses, any charging scheme must still fit this ideal.

Y – The costs proposed will be a deterrent to new start-up and FDI businesses who will be looking at other countries NRA options before deciding where to grow their business. Any charging will put us at a disadvantage against those that do not charge.
