<p>Question 3.1: Do you agree with our proposal to remove the obligation for telecoms providers to provide the local dialling facility? Please provide reasons for your response.</p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>Earlier this week proposals from OFCOM would see the ending of the ability to dial somebody in your own STD area without a code.</p> <p>e.g. We are 01372 270111 so can currently dial anybody else with a landline connected to the Esher (01372) telephone exchange without the need for the 01372 prefix.</p> <p>These proposals will , if implemented , have a number of effects on your Solitaire Pay-phones.</p> <p>* Local calls dialled with the prefix will be treated as Long Distance , if local STD code has not been programmed into the payphone as "Local"</p> <p>*Any local memory speed dial numbers programmed without the local STD prefix would no longer be routed and need to be changed.</p>
<p>Question 3.2: Do you agree with our proposal to retain the provisions in the Numbering Plan which (i) allocate location significance to area codes and (ii) allow phone users to request out-of-area use of geographic numbers? Please provide reasons for your response.</p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>If an out of area code is issued then payphone users will be charged more for that call than if the call was made using an area code which was actually local to that originating telephone line.</p>
