However, whilst in some ways it is only a designation, it does suggest by reference to paragraph 30(1) of the Code that the Site Provider is bound to provide ahead of feasibility and perhaps there should be some qualification in the code of practice that the term refers to both potential providers ahead of /subject to agreement and actual providers when consensual agreement is reached and /or rights imposed by the courts (as is the case with paragraph 30 (1)).</p>
