### Your response

<p><b>Question 1: What are your views of the use of CLI authentication to improve the accuracy of CLI information presented to an end user, in particular the viability and timeframe for implementation? Are there any issues associated with implementation?</b></p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>A check should be made that the CLI number has not been spoofed with a non-existent number or a number which differs from their actual number, and the call blocked if this is the case.</p> <p>We have experienced a large number of calls received which have non-existent numbers. The perpetrators obviously know this and drop the call when asked who they are.</p>
<p><b>Question 2: Do you have any comments on the proposed changes to the CLI guidelines?</b></p>	<p>Confidential? – Y/N</p>
<p><b>Question 3: Are there any other types of Presentation Numbers which could be added to the list in Annex 1 of the CLI guidelines?</b></p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>Replacement of a CLI number with a central switchboard enquiries number is acceptable. This practise could be registered centrally in order that the call is not blocked as mentioned at Question 1 above.</p>
<p><b>Question 4: Do you have any comments on the proposal to designate the 08979 number range as ‘Inserted Network Numbers for Calling Line Identification’ in the Numbering Plan?</b></p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>I would not like to see the 08979 number range being displayed as suggested, as this would be more expensive than a standard call if the recipient were to complete a call to this number. A number in the 03 range would be preferable.</p>
