Confidential? – N Yes I agree with this, both geographic and premises obligation. However what is the definition of acceptable coverage coverage. This should be in dB.

Encouragement should also be given for operators to share their existing masts</p>
<p>Question 7: Do you have any other comments?</p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>A definition of levels of coverage should be produced so that all is clear what the acceptable dB levels are to provide the necessary coverage.</p> <p>The 500m2 coverage area is too large, particularly in areas of poor coverage. The present 100m2 is also too large, would suggest this is reduced to 10m2 or if not practical 50m2.</p>
