<b>Question 1: Do you agree with Ofcom's proposed approach to amending the Licence set out in this consultation and the proposed amendments to the Licence set out in paragraphs 2.2 to 2.29? Please provide reasons for your views.</b>	<p>Confidential? – Y / N</p> <p>We note at 2.24 that the BBC has indicated that the BBC SC will not include Gaelic programming. We query how the BBS SC intends to fulfil condition 2.79 of the Licence (“the BBC must ensure that it provides a range of genres in its programming that reflects Scotland’s culture”) if it is excluding Gaelic programming. The existence of BBC ALBA should not create a binary approach in relation to Gaelic content on the BBC SC. The BBC 2 Scotland requirement for “including Gaelic” was a helpful and inclusive requirement and it is MG ALBA’s view that to exclude Gaelic from the BBC’s other output is a mistake.</p>
