Do you have any comments on our proposals?	Thanks for the opportunity to respond to your consultation on your 2021/22 work plan.
	I'd really urge you to include a review of PAF as part of your work plan because it's really important for the efficiency of all manner of services and other operations, some existing and some yet to be realised, particularly with the historic and potential rise of digital services.
	I believe you last reviewed PAF eight years ago, which is an enormous length of time in a digital landscape.
	In your new work plan, I believe you should be including the review of the following:
	 Whether the responsibility for PAF should be with a government depart- ment which is independent of a post- al/collection/delivery organisation.
	The potential exists for many other organisations - and not just in the postal/delivery sector - to benefit hugely from a system that takes account of the wider picture.
	Whether the data can be made available at no charge and with no restrictions on its use.
	This would improve the efficiency of many organisations, both public and private
	Whether/how access to the data can be improved for both organisations and individuals
	This too would improve the efficiency of many organisations, both public and private

Separately from the issues of PAF, I'd like to see you examine whether and how the monopoly of Royal Mail over certain types of items (eg letters and small packages) can be removed.

I believe the monopoly is holding back the efficiency of all sorts of activities in this country
