My only comments would be:

DAB has proven to be just another con trick. Equipment bought in good faith is rapidly becoming obsolete as services move from DAB to DAB+ and cannot be received on a unit that cost me several hundreds of pounds just a few years ago.

Another con trick is the way stations are broadcast in mono, yes MONO with sampling rates that yield quality that is far inferior to VHF/FM.

I appreciate the bandwidth constraints of FM and that by multiplexing, far more stations can fit into "less MHz" but we are using a band with less ability to "bend" around hills being in the 220MHz range than the far superior band 2.

DAB is being forced upon me. Speaking with friends who are also in the amateur radio fraternity, I can name not one who feels differently to the way I do.

DAB = Dreadfully Awful Broadcasting.
