<p><b>Question 1:</b> Do you have any comments on the drafting of the new template notice as set out in Annex 1?</p>	<p>Confidential? – N</p> <p>Under item 2 and in connection with our PIA product we are concerned about the potential sharing of personal / confidential data from our agreements with site providers with other operators so we would recommend the removal of the date of such an agreement and name of the site provider from this notice in the spirit of privacy and data protection guidance.</p> <p>Note that the general principle is that if we receive confidential and/or personal data from a site provider we only use that information for the original purpose that it was given to us. That's because consent was given for that purpose, and we cannot use the confidential and/or personal data for another purpose.</p> <p>Under section 5, in order for us to operate practically the changes imposed from the PSTI bill, we would require the option in the address field to include details of the sharing operator so that anyone with an interest in the land can engage with them directly rather than coming to us.</p> <p>Either within section 5 of the notice or within the notes field, we would recommend the inclusion of '<i>...this notice does not entitle the sharing operator to enter the land to survey, install or maintain their apparatus without obtaining the prior consent of the site provider</i>'.</p>

In section 8, in order for us to operate practically the changes imposed from the PSTI bill, we would require the option in the address field to include details of the sharing operator so that anyone with an interest in the land can engage with them directly rather than coming to us.
