As part of this, Three would en- courage Ofcom to consider how it monitors scheme performance (beyond the existing KPIs) to ensure consistency of approach and decision making for the benefit of both consumers and ADR scheme members. Three also notes that Ofcom is considering whether ADR providers are suffi- ciently transparent about the cases they handle, to positively improve com- plaints handling and support Ofcom's oversight of operators and the schemes. Three would welcome greater transparency in the range and qual- ity of data that is published, so it can measure its performance against indus- try and use this insight to facilitate continuous improvement.
