Your response

Do you agree that Ofcom should give its consent to the reductions in AM (medium wave) transmitter coverage proposed by Absolute Radio? If you do not agree, please give reasons. No. I do enjoy listening to Absolute on DAB but I do not have a DAB radio in every room in the house - I still frequently listen on AM around the house and in the car.

During the winter time the 1197 signal from Wallasey is much more reliable than 1215 and a lack of alternative analogue reception (FM) in the Merseyside area means that I would probably start investigating other stations on the DAB radio, if they were allowed to switch off 1197 and I couldn't listen to them reliably on 1215.

It's unfortunate that they propose this, just when the music format starts to improve.
