Whilst this is a broadcaster choice, this may result in less listenership than would otherwise be achievable.</p> <p>Maxxwave has a suitable mast site near to Langley Mill, combined with the necessary expertise to engineer such a transmission system. We could offer a higher quality solution for a lower cost, should "Birmingham Broadcasting Limited" be interested in pursuing such a solution.</p> |
