TV, two original TV series. They have been incredibly supportive in developing our approach to experimental television output. Sheffield Live! TV is providing a valuable service to the community and has been a pioneer in the community media sector through its community ownership structure and tie up with community radio. The changes to the programme commitments set out in the consultation seem very reasonable and are likely to be supported by local audiences and not fundamentally change the character of the service. Sheffield Live TV will continue to produce more local content than many other local TV channels and that the changes will increase opportunities for sharing among independent and community focussed local TV channels.
