TV is providing a valuable service to the community and has been a pioneer in the community media sector through its community ownership structure and tie up with community radio.</p> <p data-bbox="807 904 1372 1339">The changes to the programme commitments set out in the consultation seem very reasonable and are likely to be supported by local audiences and not fundamentally change the character of the service.
