

Response to: Proposal to apply Code powers to the Lonsdale Network Services Ltd

Yes. I object to the legislation 'notification under section 107(6) of the communications act 2003', which seeks to permit any of the 'electronic communications code' companies to install 5g on public land (streets) without first consulting with residents, and to the carrying out of this work without normal planning permission, and I vehemently object to the installation of 5g equipment onto privately owned land!

5g is an untested new technology which requires a great deal more investigation into its health impacts on all life forms, including humans, and its instant and cumulative effects on the environment: (perfectly healthy trees are being chopped down to erect 5g antenna poles, and the higher frequency-bands are known to cause alzheimers disease, dna damage, epilepsy, seizures and brain tumours).
