Wi-Fi Alliance supports Ofcom's proposal to fully implement the European Commission De- cision on the harmonisation of radio spectrum for use by short-range devices ("SRD") within the 874-876 and 915-921 MHz frequency bands. Across the UK, the demand for Internet of Things ("IoT") applications continues to grow. To address this demand, Wi-Fi Alliance has introduced Wi-Fi HaLow™ as the designa- tion for products incorporating IEEE 802.11ah technology. This global industry standard has been specifically designed to operate in fre- quencies below one gigahertz to deliver longer range, lower power, multi-year battery life and connectivity. Availability of the proposed fre- quencies will facilitate introduction of Wi-Fi HaLow devices into the UK for the benefit of consumers and enterprises.
