Question 1: Respondents are invited to comment on whether they agree with Ofcom's preliminary view and to frame their views and responses with reference to, or in the context of, the statutory criteria in section 106(1A) of the Broadcast Act 1990 (as amended).

I am a fairly recent convert to XS Manchester as a station on a more regular basis, but had been aware of its legendary status among like-minded music fans for some time. It provides a stunning playlist of back to back indie classics mixed with incredible fresh new music by young bands, such as the immensely talented local band Narrow Margin. This is something which few more established radio stations really do these days with the exception of BBC 6Music and possibly XFM. Manchester is the spiritual home of so many of the iconic post-punk/indie bands of the past forty years at least, including Buzzcocks, Joy Division/New Order, The Smiths, The Fall, The Charlatans, The Stone Roses, Happy Mondays, Oasis and more recently the Courteeners among many others.
