Maramedia does not agree with OFCOM's proposal. We suggest that it would be fairer if the outside England quota rose to between 12 and 16% well in advance of 2029. As a medium-sized production company, Channel 4 could be a pivotal funder in the face of much reduced tariffs from all other terrestrial broadcasters.
