Chorley FM constantly boast about the fact they broadcast "LIVE" for a minimum of 8 hours per day, yet in truth, they are lucky to do 3 hours of live shows per day, The Breakfast Show, Traffic & Travel Reports, Events Guide, Afternoon Shows, Weekend Dance Shows etc are all "Recorded Shows", more often than not, they are repeated over and over again.

Currently, Chorley FM's Key Commitments are to serve the Youth and local LGBT Community. Until recently, their "only" LGBT Show, (Breakout-Sunday eve), was repeated once or twice per week, now for some strange reason, they have taken it upon themselves to make do with one show.

This is probably because they think their requested change of Key Commitments is "In the Bag".

At the moment, they are supposed to broadcast Community News, yet their idea of News for the Community is outdated recorded Travel Reports and what shows that are coming to the local Theatre.
