I believe Chorley FM have gone above and beyond their original commitment and provide a very high quality service to the whole community, including 16-24 yr olds and the LGBT community. The output is very high quality and they are clearly attracting a good level of engagement with local businesses. To halt them in their tracks at this stage would leave the listeners, businesses, charities and of course 16-24 & LGBT groups without a service. I thoroughly recommend that the change in Format and Key Commitments is allowed.
