

**Question 2: Are there other consequences following the roll out of the service across the UK that we have not included in our assessment? If so, please explain.:**

It has been pointed out to me during discussions with neighbours that while our street is all very chummy and get on with each other, others may not have the same good relationship, or have a delicate relationship; putting a big sticker on your door saying &quot;I do not want my parcels left with neighbours&quot; or equivalent would make me, if I were in that position, feel very conspicuous and self-conscious.
