Not as currently proposed. I do not want to participate. However, to opt out I have to display a sticker and if I don't it will be assumed that I have agreed to this process. I do not wish to deface my property by displaying stickers on it in a prominent place.

Instead those who display stickers should be those prepared to take part in the scheme - and it should be assumed that those not displaying stickers are those not willing to take part.

Why do I have to deface my property for the convenience of a postal delivery service who are contractually supposed to deliver mail to my door?
