Definitely not. Royal Mail should be required to continue to deliver ALL mail to the address on the item. Moreover, those who opt out of the scheme should not be required to display a sticker. This is patently another erosion of the services provided by Royal Mail for the citizens of the United Kingdom. Royal Mail is not merely another carrier but is required by statute to provide a universal mail service to all parts of the United Kingdom.
