Question 3:Do you have any comments on the scope and wording of the proposed Notification and approval:

it should be an important principle of the 'opt in/out' procedure that a person should NOT be able to 'opt in' a neighbour who themselves have 'opted out' of having their own mail delivered elsewhere.

So it should NOT be possible for someone who has opted OUT of their own mail being delivered to a neighbour to be 'opted in' to receive other people's mail WITHOUT CONSENT.

I therefore propose that the 'opt out' provision should also contain a consequent question whether that person wishes to receive neighbours mail.
