

Everyone knows there are nice neighbours and nasty neighbours. It is self evident. People harass other people, they rob their neighbours, and abuse them. Anti-social behaviour is inbred in our nation.

I have a label on my door telling deliverers that they can leave parcels with house numbers 10, 12, 14, 16 and 12. I know from delivering election leaflets that others leave notices on their doors like this.

This is a self evident requirement that Royal Mail should have incorporated. I have checked their website. The issue does not appear on their Q and As. Clearly the person who wrote the proposal has no experience of either delivering door to door or anti-social neighbourhoods. Not really fit to write the proposal.

My proposal is that RM produce 2 door stickers:

1 saying no thanks don't leave with neighbour

1 saying yes please, you can leave with..... (sufficient room for say 5 house numbers).

Or that they clearly state in advance of the proposal what they intend to do about notes left on doors about who parcels can be left with, and leave us to make our minds up about opting in or out.

On one occasion a parcel deliverer (not RM) ignored my notice and left a parcel with a harasser and I felt very upset and threatened. I reported that person to management (though got no response back suggesting they did not give two hoots!).

Neighbour harassment is a real problem and RM have shown themselves completely ignorant of this and the fact that some people put labels on their doors.
