Regarding digital tv, we were told that by going digital there would be many additional channels available.... there are, however the programs available from those channels are mainly repeats, + 1 hour repeats, the previous days repeats, previous years repeats and a lot of rubbish. Personally I can see no benefits from the DTV service and since it's introduction there has always been reception problems as well as that fact that we are not being able to receive local news as all our programs are from a Welsh transmitter.
