I object to this proposal on the grounds that it is purely commercial in intent and entirely fails to consider the health grounds. Companies such as Vodafone continually dismiss the enormous weight of circumstantial evidence linking health problems with radiation emitted from their base stations by claiming there is no proof. The claim that ought to be given precedence is that there is no proof their technology is safe. Vodafone now want to increase the power of their base stations with the appalling comment that it is to increase in-building penetration. In other words, people that have previously had less exposure to radiation are more likely to be affected.
