Question 1: Are there any reasonable grounds why Ofcom should not grant the request to vary the five Wireless Telegraphy Third Generation Mobile Licences by increasing the permitted maximum in-band EIRP to 68dBm as soon as practicable? If so, please explain your reasoning for this:

ICNIRP guidelines are now out of date (set abt 10 yrs ago) and were only to prevent thermal affects on the body "or heating up due to microwave radiation". ICNIRP does not cover the non-thermal affects. It is the non-thermal affects that cause increase in production of cancer causing free radicals, a decrease in bodily melatonin and destruction to intercell communication.

New guidelines are now emerging as a result of the BioInitiate Report http://www.bioinitiative.org/. Many countries are dismissing ICNIRP and have lowered their emission levels, eg. AU/RU/ China so GB should NOT be looking to increase theirs.
