## Question 1: Are there any reasonable grounds why Ofcom should not grant the request to vary the five Wireless Telegraphy Third Generation Mobile Licences by increasing the permitted maximum in-band EIRP to 68dBm as soon as practicable? If so, please explain your reasoning for this:

Many of these masts are in residential areas and near schools, in the case of which I have particular concern. My son attends a primary school near a mast, which is bad enough as the main beam is across the playground, to increase microwave based power so near to where children are is totally unacceptable.
