You probably wont know me or my company MLEC UK Ltd but we act as consultants to a company in Reigate. They have over the last 10 years installed and maintained a large number of radio mic transmitters used on the underground system throughout London, at the present there are approximately 1500 transmitters available for daily use on the underground. These are used for making station and platform announcements across the entire system, these all operate within channel 70 on a PTT basis, with very little interference from other users, obviously we realise this is in the license free section and so non-interference could never be guaranteed but with the large number of units possibly going to be used on the Olympics it could be possible to render the LU system totally inoperative.
