The proposal to allow the airborne use of SRD is very welcome and will allow the introduction into the UK of devices which have, as the consultation document reports, been of demonstrable value in alerting recreational pilots to potential collisions.

Though the UK has rather different airspace usage to the alpine regions where such systems have been of such value, allowing their use in the UK will certainly improve safety at relatively low cost.

Experience in Europe has shown that there are few disadvantages to allowing these SRDs to be used and I support this change wholeheartedly.
