It is highly desirable to remove the restriction on airborne use for all SRD allocation listed in the SRD Decision as amended.

Specifically there are now airborne collision avoidance warning systems available in Europe - one manufacturer sells them under the FLARM brand - which use SRD allocations. Currently these are used overseas in areas of intensive gliding operation. Some areas have mandated them.

It will provide an opportunity to further enhance air safety in the UK if these devices are approved for airborne use in the UK.
