My response applies only to the Radio 2 extra consultation.

- 1. The BBC no longer provides a music based service for the over 55s, this will be partly addressed by Radio 2 extra.
- 2. There are now only limited format restrictions on commercial radio, so the BBC should be free to make changes.
- 3. The archive material needs to be broadcast whilst it is still of interest to a large number of listeners.

My recommendation would be to let the BBC get on with this, as I am sure the Regulator has more important matters to consider.
